1. Avril moved to accept minutes as written. Seconded. Vote: All in favor.
2. **Treasurer's Report:** Merle is absent but sent in the report that there is no change.
3. **CERT Shed Committee** Report by Dan
 - a. We are scouting for two locations in the neighborhood.
4. **Parks Committee Update by Barbara**
 - a. Met with the new chair of the Parks Advisory Commission.
 - b. Did not receive any new information however they did acknowledge there was a need for a park north of 149th St. They are confirming interest with a property seller in that area.
 - c. Our PIF dollars run out in 6 years. We are at 3.5 now for parts of the development.
 - d. We are looking for volunteers to help with this committee. Having several voices will help bring attention to this critical issue.
5. **Newsletter Distribution**
 - a. There have been cutbacks in the Clark County staffing. There is a distinct possibility that additional cutbacks could require us to do hand delivery for each issue.
 - b. We are still trying to develop our hand delivery network. If you can do your block or subdivision, please consider helping out!

 - a. H1N1 as of 7/24/09 in Washington State.
 - 122 Hospitalizations
 - 7 deaths
 - 600 confirmed cases
