

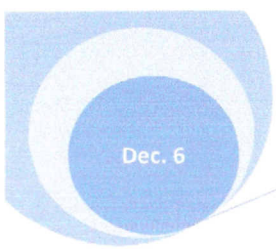


NSCNA – AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

**NORTH SALMON CREEK NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION
NONPROFIT CORPORATION
AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the nonprofit laws of the State of Washington, RCW 24.03, hereby adopts the following amended Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be North Salmon Creek Neighborhood Association.

ARTICLE II

The term of existence shall be: (check only one box): perpetual _____ (number of) years.

ARTICLE III

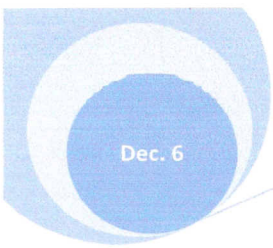
The purposes for which the corporation is organized are as follows:.

The North Salmon Creek Neighborhood Association (North Salmon Creek NA) is organized exclusively for charitable purposes as defined within section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. It was established by a group of community members residing within its boundaries and was created to unite common interests and promote, preserve, and improve the safety, welfare, and quality of life of community stakeholders, residents, neighborhoods, and communities.

The North Salmon Creek NA’s board of directors, NA’s committees, and community members shall be involved with a variety of issues including, but not limited to, matters which affect the safety, livability, and quality of life of residents, neighborhoods, and/or the community.

ARTICLE IV

The name of the registered Agent of the corporation is: Barbara Anderson
The street address of the Registered Office, which is also the address of the Registered Agent is: 105 NE 150th Street Vancouver Washington 98685-1779



ARTICLE V

There shall be 9 (nine) directors serving as the Board of Directors. Their names and addresses are as follow:

ARTICLE VI

In the event of dissolution of the corporation the net assets are to be distributed as follows:

1. If the NSCNA area is absorbed by an active neighborhood association that is structured as a 501(c)(3) corporation under the IRS code, then all funds will be transferred to that neighborhood associations treasury.
2. If the NSCNA area is NOT absorbed by an active neighborhood association meeting the above criteria, then all net assets will be donated to a non profit charitable organization that is structured within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, for a public purpose. If multiple candidate organizations are identified then the recipient will be selected by majority consensus of the last Executive Board.

CONSENT TO APPOINTMENT AS REGISTERED AGENT

I, Barbara Anderson, hereby consent to serve as Registered Agent in the state of Washington for the corporation herein named. I understand that as agent for the corporation, it will be my responsibility to accept Service of Process in the name of the corporation; to forward all mail to the corporation, and to immediately notify the Office of the Secretary of State in the event of my resignation or of any change in the Registered Office address of the corporation for which I am agent.
