

# **Bylaws for North Salmon Creek Neighborhood Association**

## **NAME**

The name of this association shall be called North Salmon Creek Neighborhood Association.

## **OBJECT**

The North Salmon Creek Neighborhood Association is established by the residents of the neighborhood in order to unite the common interests and promote the welfare of the neighborhood and its residents. The neighborhood association shall concern itself with a variety of problems including but not limited to, matters effecting livability and quality of the neighborhood and the community in general.

## **BOUNDARIES**

The boundaries of the North Salmon Creek Neighborhood Association were established as reaching to NW 149st to the north, Salmon Creek to the south, I-5 to the east and NW 29th Avenue to the west.

## **MEMBERSHIP**

The membership of the North Salmon Creek Neighborhood Association is open to all residents, home owners, managers of multiple-family dwellings and non-profit organizations within the boundaries of this neighborhood.

## **OFFICERS**

The officers of the North Salmon Creek Neighborhood Association shall be a president, vice president and secretary/treasurer. The above officers shall preside over all meetings, planning sessions and activities of the Neighborhood Association.

## **MEETINGS**

The board of the Neighborhood Association must meet not less than once a month to discuss neighborhood business. All decisions made by the Board must be confirmed by a meeting of the general membership. All decisions must be reached by majority vote of the membership attending the general meeting.

## **EXECUTIVE BOARD**

Members of the Executive board will include the officers and the committee chairpersons. All officers must reside within the boundaries of the neighborhood.

## **SPECIAL COMMITTEES**

Special committees to handle specific concerns may be appointed by the president as necessary.

## **VOTING**

All eligible members' eighteen (18) years old and older are entitled to one(1) vote, but must have attended a general meeting within the previous six (6) calendar months prior to the current meeting. This requirement pertains to all neighborhood matters except for the election of officers, which will require members to have attended at least two(2) general meetings in the prior six(6) months.

## **ELECTION OF OFFICERS**

Officers shall be elected annually. Officers are limited to two terms consecutively. Elections to refill vacant positions shall occur whenever such vacancies occur.

## **AMENDMENTS TO THE BYLAWS**

These bylaws may be amended at any general meeting by a two-thirds(2/3) vote, the proposed amendments having been submitted in writing and read to the membership at a general meeting at least one week before being voted upon.

## **FUNDING:**

Membership fees shall not bar any resident from membership or voting. Voluntary contributions, contracts, grants, subscriptions or fund-raising activities may be used by the Neighborhood Association.

Checks written on the North Salmon Creek Neighborhood Association bank account must be signed by two of the three officers. The association will have its own Federal ID number and be registered as a non-profit organization.
